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**POPULARIZATION OF THE SCIENTIFIC FOREIGN LANGUAGE  
RESEARCH WORK AT SPORTS ACADEMY STUDENTS**

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**Key words:** *language research work, students, scientific, motivation.*

**Abstract:** *Modern transformations in the field of education involve the direct participation of students in language research work activities. However, only a small part of the surveyed students of Sports Academy are engaged in the publication of scientific articles, participate in conferences, symposia, competitions, etc. The article suggests methods of stimulation and motivation that*

*a university can take to increase the number of sports students doing language research work.*

**Introduction.** The requirements for sports specialists graduating from Sports Academy are growing every year. The qualification of a specialist must meet accepted standards and be increased annually. One of the main requirements for education is the diversity of educational methods in order to prepare young specialists with a wide range of application of the knowledge and skills they have acquired, to form their creative application of the knowledge they have acquired and to adapt it to the conditions of a changing working environment [1].

**Research results and their discussion.** To study this topic, we conducted a survey in which we interviewed 2nd year sports students about their language research work. More than half (58%) of the respondents answered that they had heard about this work, but never even thought about writing scientific articles themselves. A quarter considers it to be of little use for their future career, and
