Nevertheless, the main thing is global: they have state sports development programs № 1 for women (half of the country's population), we have this half forcibly excluded from football. INFLUENCE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER'S STYLE OF PEDAGOGICAL ATTITUDE ON INTEREST IN HIS LESSONS

Abstract. This article raises the issue of the influence of the communication style and the teacher's attitude towards students on their interest in the lessons of these teachers. The study is based on the results of a survey conducted among students of the 9th parallel of Lyceum N = 35, the purpose of which was to identify the percentage of how students see their teacher of physical education. According to the results of the study, active-positive and mixed styles turned out to be the most popular, which is a significant indicator, as it guarantees the best study of the school curriculum and increased physical fitness.

Introduction

Relevance. The problem of relations between teachers and students is probably one of the earliest in pedagogical research, but not losing its relevance in modern conditions [1]. Therefore, in our research, we also conducted a scientific search in this direction.

The purpose of the research: to identify how the style of pedagogical attitude affects the learning process in physical education classes in secondary school.

Results of the study and their discussion. We interviewed students of the 9th grade of Lyceum № 35 in order to find out what style of pedagogical attitude is common among teachers. The survey included descriptions of various styles of pedagogical attitude, in which it was necessary to relate the teacher of physical education with the proposed description. According to the results of the survey, 39% of respondents believe that their physical education teacher has a mixed style of pedagogical attitude, 37% answered that their teacher has an active-positive style, 22% note.

The physical condition and fitness of students suffer especially, since one of the goals of physical education at school is to teach motor actions and maintain the mandatory weekly activity of students. Therefore, with this style of teaching, students suffer both mentally and physically.
